

Types of Exhibition Space

Pop Up Banner Sites



Ideal for companies that have not previously taken part in exhibitions - and would like to try it out. Or for those on a limited or reduced budget.



A Pop Up Banner Site gives you enough room to display a roller banner and promote your products and services to visitors and other exhibitors.



This option gives you a visible presence at the event without breaking the bank.

Space Only Sites

Exhibitors needing a larger space, but not requiring the Shell Scheme format, can opt for a Space Only Site.

and, depending on the venue, many shapes and sizes of display can be accommodated.

As you might expect, you can order the amount of space that is most suitable for your own particular requirements

A trestle table and two chairs are included within Space Only packages.



Shell Scheme Sites

Most exhibitors choose to display within a Shell Scheme space. A range of sizes are available but the most popular tends to be a 3m x 2m space. This provides an exhibition space which is three metres wide and two metres deep, and approximately 2.4 metres high.

One advantage with this option is that smaller companies can promote themselves professionally even if they don't have expensive exhibition equipment. Shell Scheme sites are made up of connecting 1m wide panels which are velcro compatible (so posters etc.

can be affixed directly) with a fascia at the top which features the stand number and Company Name.

A trestle table and two chairs are included within Shell Scheme packages, and spotlights and power sockets can be ordered as required.
